#### The undersigned hereby certifies that

- the applicant is not insolvent,
- bids placed in the auction originate from the applicant, and
- the applicant at the time of the application meets and during the auction will meet applicable provisions in PTS' regulations (PTSFS 2008:1) regarding spectrum auctions, amended through PTSFS 2010:5, PTSFS 2016:2 and PTSFS 2018:XX, PTS regulations (PTSFS 2018:2) regarding a combined selection procedure for licences to use radio transmitters in the 700 MHz band and the open invitation.

**The undersigned applicant will, if the undersigned becomes a holder of a licence to use radio transmitters in the 700 MHz band, take the following steps:**

- contribute to immediately establish a cooperation between the licence holders in 713–733 MHz, 738–758 MHz and 768–788 MHz, with the aim of coordinating measures to resolve interference (according to the definition of TV interference in the open invitation, **Appendix A**) in the reception of terrestrial TV in the frequency band 470–694 MHz for a permanently resident population,
- ensure that the cooperation between the licence-holders immediately offers a joint point of contact with good availability, at least by phone, to which TV viewers whose TV reception is affected by the use in the 700 MHz band can file a report,
- coordinate the aforementioned contact point with the one established for TV viewers whose TV reception is affected by the use in the 800 MHz band,
- keep a register of received reports,
- immediately contribute to identifying what licence-holder(s) are causing the TV interference in the frequency band 470-694 MHz,
- as soon as possible thereafter, free-of-charge arrange investigation and, if the interference source is attributable to the undersigned, free-of-charge resolve the confirmed TV interference in a suitable manner, and
- if necessary, immediately turn off interfering base station transmitters or repeaters or terminals installed by the licence-holder until the TV interference is resolved.

## **Instructions to applicants to participate in the auction for licences to use radio transmitters in the 700 MHz band**

- The application to participate in the auction for licences to use radio transmitters in the 700 MHz band shall be made on this form.
- The application must have been received by PTS no later than 5 November 2018.
- The application shall be submitted in a sealed envelope. Mark the envelope with "Ansökan 700 MHz-tilldelning".
- The application shall be signed by an authorised company signatory and submitted as an original copy.

### **The following documents shall be appended to the application:**

- The original power of attorney, if the application is signed by somebody other than an authorised company signatory.
- A transcript from the Swedish business register (or equivalent for foreign applicants) that confirms information on company name, authorised company signatories and corporate identity number.
- A bank guarantee of SEK 50 million. Use the PTS template for the bank guarantee; see Appendix D to the open invitation.
- Information on who the applicant's related parties are according to the related party rule in the open invitation.

An application that is received too late or does not contain a bank guarantee in accordance with that stated in the open invitation will be rejected. An application that otherwise is not complete may be refused or rejected.
